

Adding a Geographically Distant Participating Site Review Committee for Emergency Medicine

The Review Committee requires additional information from programs that wish to add a geographically distant participating site.

Any program that will require rotations at a site that entails extended travel (consistently more than half an hour each way), or if the distance between the site and the Sponsoring Institution exceeds 60 miles, must complete and submit a table to clarify the site's use to the Review Committee.
