Re: Next Resident Member of the Transitional Year Review Committee

The Transitional Year Review Committee (TYRC) is composed of members that represent the wide variety of the ACGME's constituent organizations, as well as relevant specialty-specific professional organizations. The Committee is requesting nominations for its next resident member for a two-year term to begin on July 1, 2027.

Qualifications of the Resident Member

The resident member must have completed an ACGME-accredited transitional year program after June 30, 2026, and must be enrolled in an ACGME-accredited residency at the time of the appointment. The resident may not serve more than one year beyond completion of residency or fellowship. The term of appointment is two years. Upon completion of a two-year term, the individual may not be appointed again to the same Review Committee.

Resident members may not serve on two Review Committees simultaneously and must not be from the same institution or city/metropolitan area as another member of the committee. At the time of the next resident member's appointment, these states and institutions will include:

- Mayo Clinic, Phoenix, Arizona
- Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine, Baltimore, Maryland
- Naval Medical Leader and Professional Development Command, Bowie, Maryland
- Wayne State University School of Medicine, Detroit, Michigan
- Henry Ford Health-Jackson, Jackson, Michigan
- Oregon Health & Science University, Portland, Oregon
- Intermountain Health, Murray, Utah
- Emplify Health by Gundersen Health System, LaCrosse, Wisconsin

It is preferable but not obligatory that nominees have service experience as a member of a Program Evaluation Committee (PEC).

Nominees should have knowledge of the ACGME accreditation process.

Responsibilities of the TYRC Resident Member

The resident member participates as a full voting member in all TYRC activities, including program review and policy discussion. The resident member is subject to the same confidentiality, conflict of interest, duality of interest, and fiduciary responsibility policies of the other members. The resident member must be able to devote an estimated 15-20 hours to program review before each Review Committee meeting.

The resident member is also a member of the ACGME Council of Review Committee Residents (CRCR). The CRCR is composed of the resident member(s) of each Review Committee and is an important part of the ACGME because it provides valuable input and feedback to the ACGME Board of Directors about matters related to residents and fellows, graduate medical education, and accreditation from the resident/fellow perspective. The CRCR meets twice a year, typically in May and September.

Note: It is the program director's responsibility to ensure that the resident member will have the necessary time to review programs, attend Review Committee and CRCR meetings, and participate in activities of the Review Committee and the ACGME as is required for Review Committee members. While this nomination is for a term that officially begins July 1, 2027, the resident member will begin participating in activities six months prior to that start date in order to observe one CRCR meeting and one Review Committee meeting.

Selection of Next Resident Member

The Review Committee will review nominations in September and forward its selection to the ACGME Board of Directors for approval.

To Submit Nominations

Please submit all of the following required documents for each nominated resident:

- ACGME Review Committee Resident Member Nomination Form
- Resident curriculum vitae
- Personal statement from the resident
- Letter of support from the nominee's program director ensuring that the individual will have sufficient time to review programs, attend Review Committee and CRCR meetings, and participate in activities of the committee and the ACGME as expected

The Review Committee meets two times annually, typically in April and December. The April and December meetings are held at the ACGME office in Chicago, Illinois. All travel and meeting expenses are covered by the ACGME.
